POSITION TITLE: Sustainable Construction Faculty (Full Time)

INSTITUTION: Kennebec Valley Community College (KVCC) is a 2-year comprehensive community college in the center of Maine serving approximately 2400 students from Somerset, Kennebec, and Knox counties and well beyond. In 2014, KVCC expanded its Fairfield-based operation to include a new 600-acre Harold Alfond Campus in Hinckley, Maine. Over the past four years, KVCC has invested over \$30 million in college programs, infrastructure, and buildings including the largest carpentry lab in the northeast (7,300 sq. ft.) with a new state of the art classroom. Additional construction included the new KVCC Center for Science and Agricultural Education, the 120-acre organic farm at KVCC (including education facility, vegetable processing center, equipment, implements, systems, soils, livestock, greenhouses, shelters, fields), a new state-of-the-art culinary arts facility and demonstration kitchen, an indoor electrical lineworker training facility, two medical simulation labs, an early childhood outdoor family education lab, a CNC machine tool lab, a welding lab, and many other important updates including a vast overhaul of IT equipment, software, and computers. KVCC's new Alfond Campus and the revitalized Fairfield campus offer an unparalleled environment for inspiring new academic energy and innovative thinking. KVCC is a collegial environment emphasizing student success and respect for employees, students, and the community.

SALARY/BENEFITS: Salary and benefits commensurate with the Agreement between the Maine Community College System Trustees and the MEA Faculty Unit. Benefits include: Retirement choice of Maine Public Employees Retirement System (MainePERS) or Teachers Insurance & Annuity Association College Retirement Equities Fund (TIAA-CREF) - in lieu of Social Security; full employee health/dental insurance and approximately 60% of cost for dependent coverage; life insurance paid by the MCCS; Personal 2 days/year; and Sick 9 days/academic year.

QUALIFICATIONS: An Associate's degree or higher degree in a related field is desired, but an impressive and extensive background in construction is the minimum requirement, a knowledge of timber frame carpentry desirable. An educational background instructing high school, college level, or the workforce is required. The candidate must have both teaching and field-based construction experience. Candidates who hold OSHA10 and OSHA30 certifications are preferred. The ideal candidate will have a strong command of all hand and power tools; a dedication to jobsite safety; versatile carpentry skills from framing to finish (experience in restoration/preservation carpentry is ideal; experience with timber frame construction is desired); an understanding of and basic proficiency in mechanical and renewable energy systems and the building envelopes sub trades (e.g. plumbing, electrical, site survey, foundation, roofing, weatherization, heating and cooling); and a solid understanding and appreciation for the latest practices and technologies where whole-house performance or green/sustainable building is concerned. Demonstrated professionalism and interpersonal skills in collaborating with colleagues and directing students are essential. Experience working with architects and general contractors and sub-contractors is desirable. Site supervisor and/or small business ownership experience, print reading, CAD, and/or Sketchup software proficiency is desirable.

RESPONSIBILITIES: Kennebec Valley Community College is seeking a dynamic, experienced construction professional, craftsman, and educator to take this young program to the next level. Primary responsibilities will include teaching courses in carpentry and sustainable construction; curriculum development; student learning outcome assessment; academic advising; coordinating adjunct faculty; coordinating program advisory committee activities; and managing the program budget. Schedule may include day, evening, and online classes. Familiarity with instructional technology is desirable.
