## **KVCC “Admit in a Day” event scheduled August 18**

**Fairfield, ME** – Kennebec Valley Community College (KVCC) will hold its annual “Admit in a Day” event August 18<sup>th</sup>, giving potential students a one-stop option for enrolling in a program for the Fall 2016 semester.

The event will be held from 1-5 p.m. in the Carter Hall Multi-purpose Room on the Fairfield campus. Those interested should plan to bring an official, sealed copy of their high school transcript, immunization records, and 2015 federal tax forms and W-2 forms.

The event is free and open to the public and the application fee will be waived for those attending.

“Applying to college can be daunting enough, and making the decision to attend later in the summer can add to this,” KVCC Dean of Students Karen Normandin said. “This event is a great way to take much of the stress and complexity out of the admissions process, and most of our students are able to enroll in a program in a single afternoon.”

Prospective students will be guided by professional advisors as they take placement tests, fill out applications, apply for financial aid, and be reviewed for admission in a four hour period.
