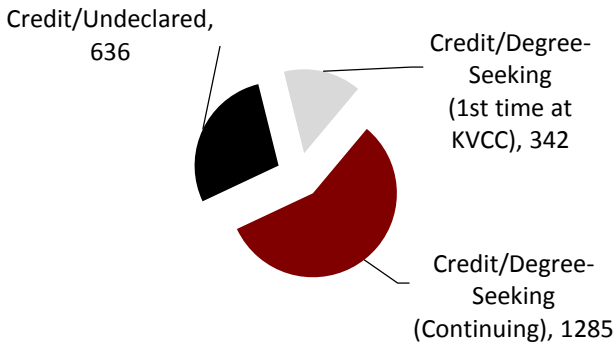
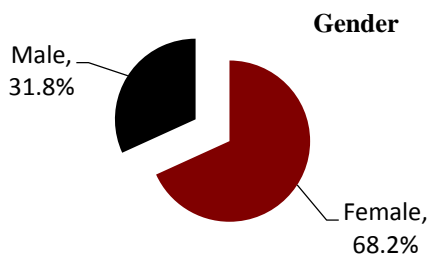


Kennebec Valley Community College is one of seven community colleges which operates under the authority of the Maine Community College System Board of Trustees.

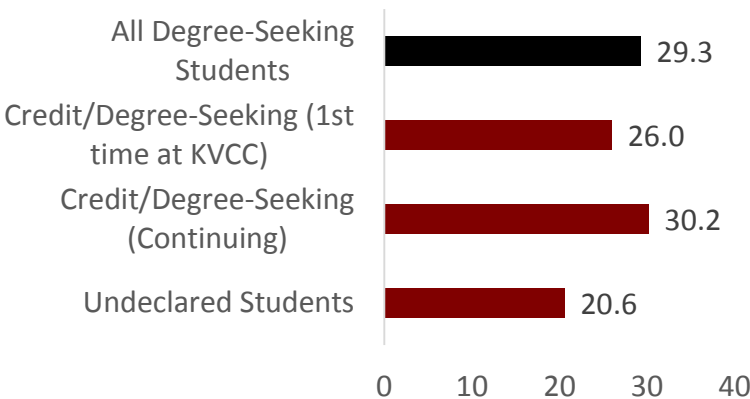

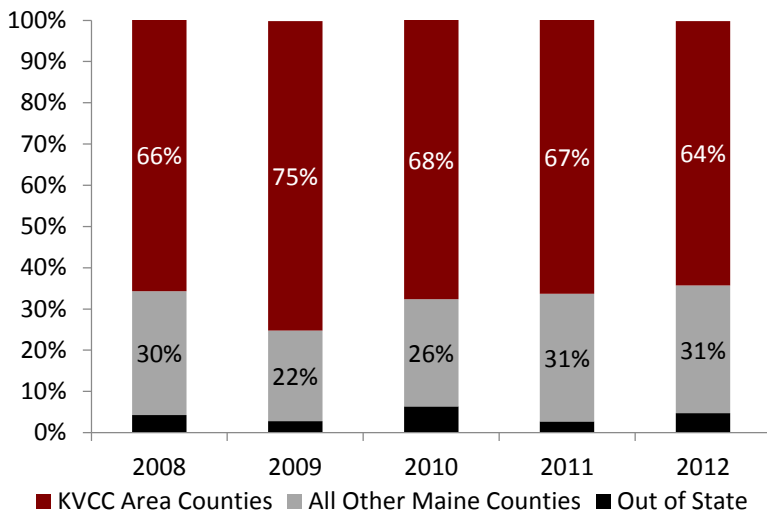
